All artworks will be made available for sale online at www.cure3.co.uk on Monday 13th March at 8am.

The artworks can only be bought online and payment will be made via a credit or debit card – Visa, Mastercard or American Express - so please ensure you have all your card details to hand.

We would advise that you notify your card provider in advance to ensure that authorisation is in place.

Step 1: Go to Artworks page at www.Cure3.co.uk

Step 2: Click on the image of the artwork you wish to buy.

Step 3: Add artwork to the cart

<u>Step 4:</u> Repeat above process if you wish to buy more than one artwork.

Step 5: Once finished, go to checkout where your order will be displayed.

Step 6: If satisfied click on 'Pay Now'.

<u>Step 7</u>: You will then be asked to enter an email address and billing address, once done click on 'Payment Info'.

Step 8: Please enter your credit or debit card information (number, expiry date and cvv)

Step 9: Click 'Buy Now'.

<u>Step 10</u>: If successful you will receive a Confirmation of Purchase Email and a separate email receipt. Please keep documents safe as these will act as proof of purchase.

- 3. The price is the full selling price. The Cure Parkinson's Trust is not VAT registered and all artworks from this charitable event are exempt from VAT.
- 4. All purchases to be made online via www.cure3.co.uk
- 5. All payments will be made by credit or debit card. It may be advisable to notify your card provider in advance to increase limit authorisation and/or to inform the provider of your intended purchase, this is so that no delays occur.
- 6. The Cure Parkinson's Trust, Cure³ and its suppliers accept no liability for any failure or delay in executing purchases via the online service.
- 7. The Cure Parkinson's Trust, Cure³ and its suppliers provide the online service and the Cure³ website "as is" and without any warranty or condition, express, implied or statutory. - 8. The artworks will be exhibited at Bonhams, 101 New Bond Street, London W1S 1SR from 13th March to 15th March 2017 (inclusive), open to the public at 9.30 am to 5.30 pm daily.
- 9. The buyer is responsible for all transport, additional packing and insurance costs and arrangements, and where necessary, complying with all UK export and receiving country import regulations.
- 10. The Cure³ team will undertake a condition check upon de-installation and the artwork will be packed by professional art handlers ready for collection or delivery.
- 11. The artworks will be ready for pick up from the Collections Desk at Bonhams, 7 Blenheim Street, W1S 1LG, from Friday 17th March until Thursday 30th March 2017 inclusive. Please note that the Collections Desk at Bonhams is open Mondays to Fridays between 9am and 4.30 pm.
- 12. The buyer must keep the email confirming purchase and receipt (print or digital) as proof of purchase, and have this paperwork available upon collection of the artwork or artworks together with a Photo ID.
- 13. Should the buyer wish to view the artwork before pick up, it will be at the buyer's own risk and responsibility to unpack, examine and repack the artwork.
- 14. Should the buyer appoint an agent to collect the artwork, notification with full details must be provided at least 24 hours in advance to cure3@cureparkinsons.org.uk (proof of purchase and photo ID of collecting agent will also be required).
- 15. Uncollected artworks will be transferred to 01 Art Services Storage on Friday 31st March 2017. From this date, the buyer will be liable for storage and release fees.
- 16. English law shall apply to the whole of these terms and conditions.

Uncollected artworks will be transferred to 01 Art Services, Unit 2 Towcester Road, London E3 3ND on Thursday 31st March 2017.
